

DIRECTIONS to MRC (Monteith Research Center)

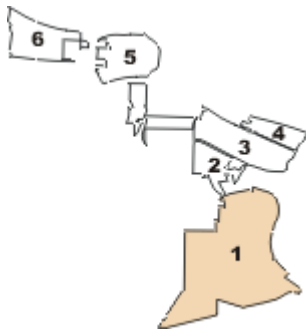
For visitors to Michael Steer, Room 435 Monteith Research Center

NOTE: You must get a parking permit to park on campus. There is an information booth where you will be able to get a \$2 parking permit. The parking deck is in front of the building and underground. You can park anywhere in the parking deck on in the outside visitor spaces.

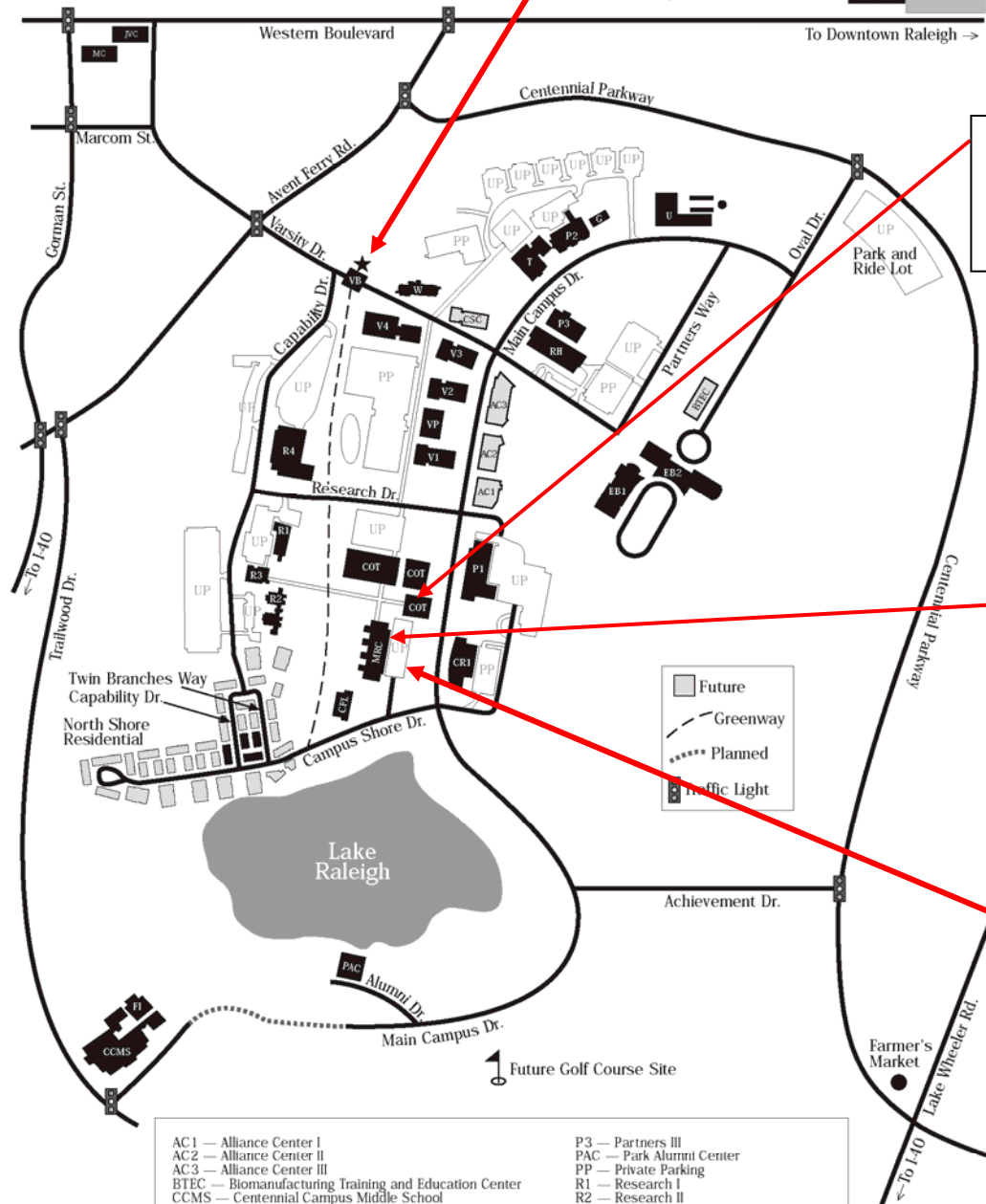
The airport serving NCSU and Raleigh is the Raleigh Durham International Airport (RDU).

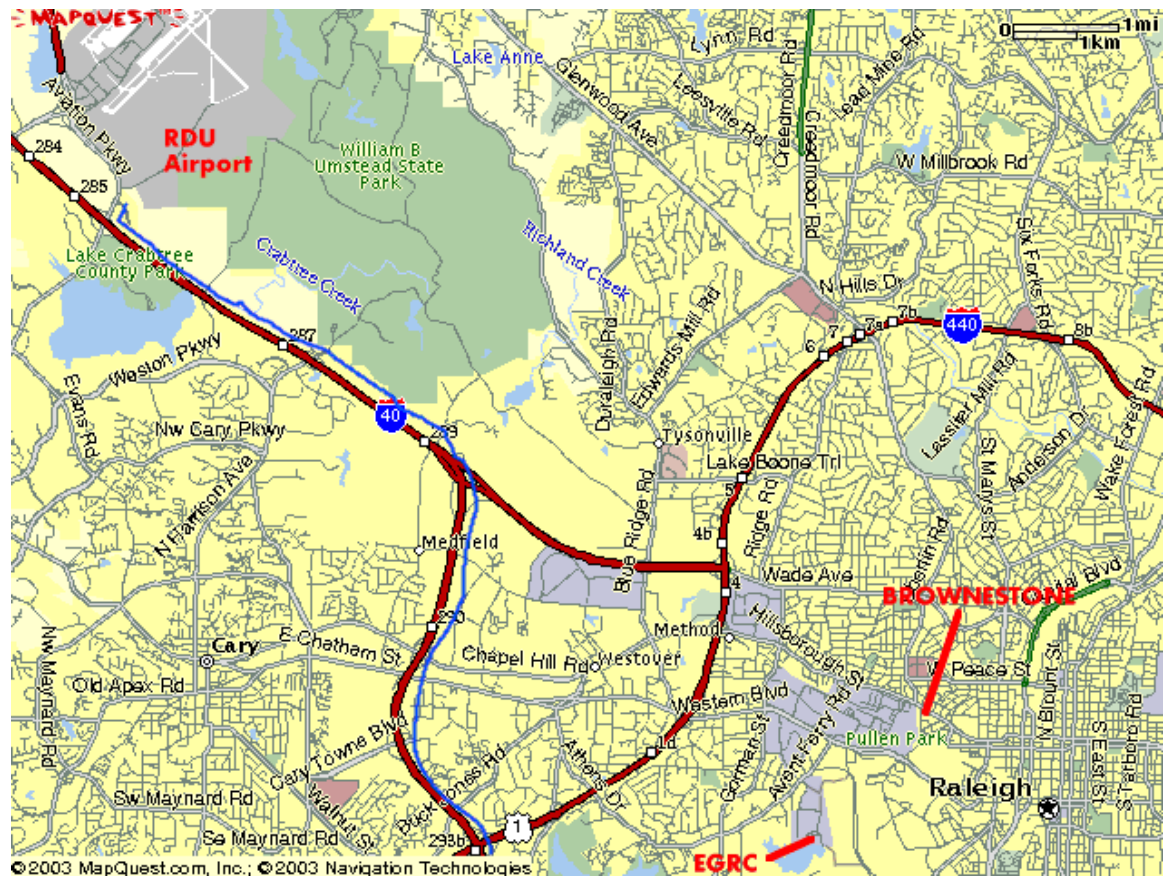

Directions from RDU Airport to MRC

1. Exit the airport and take I-40 East towards Raleigh.
2. At **EXIT 289**. **There is a tricky fork in I-40 when its splits off to Wade Avenue Extension. Stay in the left lanes to continue on I-40.**
3. **Exit 297** Exit onto Lake Wheeler Road and turn left at top of the ramp.
4. Continue over I-40 and take the first left on to Centennial Boulevard (do not take the ramp back onto I-40).
5. Take the first left and then right at the T.
6. Continue to the Monteith Research Center (MRC, formerly EGRC) and park anywhere in the deck or outside in the visitor parking spaces. You need a permit, if we told you that we would get one for you then we will have one ready for you (please call just before you arrive, 919-522-2610) We need good notice to do this.
7. Otherwise, you will need to continue to the information booth to get a parking permit. State that you are meeting me and would like a parking permit. They may charge you \$2, depends on the color of the sky.
8. Enter the MRC building can do this from the parking deck (underground), or climb the stairs. My room is MRC 421.
